TRASH PICKUP SPECIFICATIONS

1. **Trash pickup days**
 - a. **Monday and Thursday** for the **West** Side of Mason Rd
 - b. **Tuesday and Friday** for the **East** Side of Mason Rd
 - c. Pickup time between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm
2. **Curbside pickup** for each home for a maximum of 6 45-gallon standard-sized cans per day. Trash Cans provided by the customer.
3. **Yard waste:** includes landscape pots & tubs, small tree stumps, branches, & trimmings less than 4 inches in diameter, grass & leaves, and items excluded from Green Waste Program. Small quantities of individual homeowner grass and leaves should be placed in sturdy plastic bags. Trimmings and branches should be cut and tied and bundled in 4 foot lengths and weigh less than 40 pounds. A maximum of 6 bags and/or bundles will be picked up per pickup day.
4. **Holidays are:** New Year's Day; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Thanksgiving Day; and Christmas Day. If your trash pickup day falls on a holiday, your trash will not be picked up. It will be picked up on your next regularly scheduled pickup day following the observed holiday. If the holiday does not fall on your regular trash pickup day, you will be picked up on both of your scheduled days. For other holidays trash will be picked up subject to landfills being open.
5. **Bulk items:** Placed at the curb. Items will be picked up at no charge, or, depending on the size, amount of labor, handling, or dump expenses, homeowner will be billed separately at a negotiated price. Items not picked up will be tagged explaining reason and number to call.
6. **EXCLUDED ITEMS:** acids; batteries; car parts; car tires; chemicals; construction trash (to include concrete, large quantities or rolls of carpeting, fencing, construction material and debris); dirt; garage door openers; hazardous or toxic or radioactive waste; large pieces of glass (must be broken and placed in cardboard box and weigh less than 40 pounds); gravel; human or animal fecal waste (if not contained in plastic bag or closed boxes so employees do not come into direct contact with fecal material while loading into truck); large sofas and sleepers and furniture with metal frames; metal items; paint; petroleum products or filters; refrigerators (if Freon is not removed and refrigerator tagged); rocks; sand. **Homeowner may call Customer Service at 713-526-1536 and arrange pickup for excluded items pick up at a negotiated price.**

HOUSEHOLD RECYCLING PROGRAM

1. **Curbside recycling** is collected **weekly** (all year) on the first trash pickup day
 - a. **Monday** for the **west** side of Mason Rd
 - b. **Tuesday** for the **east** side of Mason Rd
2. **Accepted items:** Aluminum cans, tin cans, cardboard boxes, newspapers, magazines, plastic bottles, and glass.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE placed in the 18 gallon recycle bin and set at the curb. Excess items including your plastic, aluminum cans, and metal food cans, glass, magazines, and newspaper should be placed in see-thru plastic bags (except black or dark green) on top of or beside the recycle bin.

3. **Excluded Items:** No landscape pots, trays, or tubs, no hazardous chemical containers, no paint or oil cans, no gasoline cans, no metal pieces, no aerosol cans, no plastic furniture, no coat hangers, no Styrofoam containers or pellets.
4. **HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:** If a holiday falls on a scheduled recycle day, the recycle will be picked up on the next regularly scheduled recycle collection day following the observed holiday.

GREEN WASTE RECYCLING PROGRAM

March 1 thru October 31

Green Waste Collected at Curb by a “separate Green Waste truck” - hauled to green waste recycle facility.

NOTE: Green waste is defined as grass, plants, or trees, or living material which grow by photosynthesis. Green waste includes only “Green Waste.”

- a. **Accepted Green Waste Items:** (all green waste tied, bundled, in 4 feet lengths when applicable, or in tied plastic bags).
- b. **Grass Clippings:** Tied and put in plastic bags of sufficient strength to support 40 pounds.
- c. **Tree Trimmings:** Tree branches less than 4 inches in diameter and tied and bundled in lengths of less than 4 feet and weighing less than 40 pounds.
- d. **Excluded Items From Green Waste:** No concrete, dirt, fencing, tree stumps larger than 4 inches, metal, plastic, landscape pots and tubs.
